

## SHALL Meeting Minutes – 8<sup>th</sup> November 2010

### SHA Ladies League Meeting Barnes Hockey Club Monday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2010

Apologies – Marilyn Walker (Chairman); Sue Strachan (Results Secretary), Mel Cassell (Matchday Secretary), Bridget O'Leary (Website Administrator); Old Georgians; Woking; Old Cranleighans

The meeting was chaired by the Secretary in the absence of the Chairman.

The following points were discussed:

#### Match Report Forms (Rule 7):

The Results Secretary asked that all teams ensure that they check the following details before sending in their forms:

- Header information (division, date, venue, time & team names/numbers)
- Record if a player is playing their 2<sup>nd</sup> game of the day against their name
- Shirt numbers on the form must accurately reflect the actual shirt number worn by each player on the day (not squad number)

A fine will be levied for forms received after Wednesday and a further fine or points deduction may be incurred if no form is sent in.

A reminder was issued not to text in results or send in a Match Report Form for conceded games – email the Matchday Secretary and Results Secretary to advise them that the match was conceded.

#### Player Registration / Nominated Player Lists:

Clubs were reminded of the player eligibility rules:

Clubs with team in National League must nominate 11 players ineligible to play in SHALL (BHE, Surbiton)

Clubs with team in South Leagues – 8 nominated players (Epsom, Guildford, Richmond, Spencer, Sunbury & Walton Hawks, Tulse Hill & Dulwich, Wanderers, Wimbledon, Woking)

More than 1 team in a division (Rule 4.4) – 8 nominated players:

Div 1 – Wimbledon 2 & 2A

Div 2 – London Wayfarers 2 & 3

Div 4 – BHE 3 & Vets

Div 8 – Richmond 5 & 6

Div 10 – Addiscombe 2 & 3

The rules require that the list of nominated players is received by the end of October, however, this deadline was extended to the end of November.

## SHALL Meeting Minutes – 8<sup>th</sup> November 2010

### Player Eligibility:

Clubs were reminded that, to play in the SHA Ladies League, a player must be registered on FixturesLive to play for that club and may only play in one league match per weekend unless they qualify under rule 4.4 (goalkeepers). For rearranged matches, rule 6.4 applies.

### FixturesLive:

Clubs were reminded that under Rule 5.6, it is a requirement that each team has a matchday contact number listed on FixturesLive. Failure to comply with this rule will result in a fine.

### Rule breaches:

Fines – the list of fines currently on the website was passed around for teams to check and clubs were reminded to check the page regularly

### Points deductions:

Division 8: Woking 3 v Merton 2 on 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2010. Merton fielded 5 players who had not played 50% of their league matches for Merton 2 (having played mostly for Merton 1). This contravened rule 6.4. The result of the match has been overturned and the win awarded to Woking 3.

### SHALL Website:

- Clubs were reminded that there is a lot of useful information on the website ([www.surreyladieshockeyleague.co.uk](http://www.surreyladieshockeyleague.co.uk)) and the Website Administrator, Bridget O'Leary, would appreciate any constructive feedback about it
- Fines – the Fines page on the website is being updated and clubs need to check this regularly. Payment by cheque (payable to Surrey Hockey Association) should be sent to the Results Secretary

### Any Other Business:

Several emails have been received by the Secretary complaining about umpiring. The meeting was reminded that the League cannot make any rulings on umpiring decisions and encouraged those attending to promote umpiring and courteous behaviour towards umpires in order to improve the take-up of umpiring by more players.

A request was received from the captains of London Wayfarers 3 and Tulse Hill & Dulwich 3 to be allowed to replay their Division 2 league match from 30<sup>th</sup> October because, for various reasons beyond their control, the match had to be abandoned with 50 seconds still on the clock. The score at the time was 4-4 and a penalty corner had been awarded to London Wayfarers when the floodlights went off. Having outlined these events to the meeting, the Secretary argued that the result should stand as it was valid under League rules as 50 minutes had been played and that allowing a replay would set a dangerous precedent for other matches.
